
## **Survey on the Perception of Research Integrity**




# Trust in Science

Fighting COVID-19 with reliable information

"Trust in Science" was developed by the Path2Integrity team as part of the EC-organized #EUvsVirus hackathon. Based on the initial project research results, "Trust in Science" seeks to combat mistrust in science and to contest the misinformation and disinformation seen during the pandemic on basic questions such as how we can protect ourselves or how to combat the virus. The tool became a winner in the category of Social and Political Cohesion, in particular in Mitigating the spread of fake news. ## Path2Integrity's open science collection



Path2Integrity's open science collection is now part of the RIO Journal! The first addition of the collection contains a compendium of curricula in which research integrity (RI), research ethics (RE) or associated fields are mentioned from across Europe, including Bulgaria, Denmark, Germany, Poland and Spain. An abridged version of the Path2Integrity's grant proposal is the second addition to the open science collection. The document provides extensive information about the project's specific objectives, overall aims, concept and methodology, while also highlighting the expected impacts of the project and the plan for their implementation.


